In one country, my main objective was to meet a certain group of believers within a particular village to encourage them in the faith. Other than that, my Hmong friend and translator from the US, Boua Long, planned out our schedule. Boua Long and I had dinner a couple of times with some of his relatives he hadn't seen for years (or not maybe at all, I can't recall.) They live on the outskirts of the city, but the road to their home was quite difficult. It wasn't paved and had numerous large, unavoidable potholes. It was

an extremely bumpy ride! I was utterly amazed when they told me they have to travel that way daily to go to work in the city.

Fortunately, they had motorbikes as well, which helped zigzagging between the potholes. But when it rains (which it did), things can get quite treacherous!

At those dinners, I was pleased to meet three young people (two siblings and a cousin) who could speak some English. The more we talked, the more I realized they understood me, and we ended up have a good conversation getting to know one another. Even more exciting is that they have a heart for God and are leaders within a

youth group of 30-40 students as part of a local church that meets at their home. During our time together, our conversation led to the topic of prophecy, and I introduced them to the 316 Prophetic Seminar Series. They seemed very interested and eager to start the course online with me! They mentioned my English was clearer than their university professors. So now we meet online weekly where they are able to enhance their knowledge of English and learn more about God's Word at the same time!

We visited more of Boua Long's relatives in a Hmong village high up in the mountains. (Getting there wouldn't have even been possible if it had rained.) Previously, he conversed with them online or via email and hadn't seen them in decades. Many are believers, and we had a wonderful time together.

It was one large family reunion! I can't go into all the details, but it was a very emotional time for Boua Long and for me as well. Although I'm not directly related to them, I have been adopted as part of the Moua clan, and was warmly welcomed as part of the family and look forward to seeing them again someday whether in this life or eternity!
